

Code Of Conduct - On Cityrail

Remember, your behaviour travelling on CityRail, will be noted by other travellers – their opinion of you and your school is important.

To ensure your safety and the comfort of other passengers

Students are required to:

- Behave safely at all times
- Respect the needs and comfort of other passengers.
- Respect public property by not marking or damaging it.
- Always follow instructions about safety.
- Show their pass or ticket when required.
- You can only travel between the two stations shown on their pass, and can't break your journey.
- You are the only person allowed to use your pass.
- Use the automatic gates to enter and leave the station.

Students MUST not:

- Smoke in prohibited areas
- Allow any part of their body to protrude from the train.
- Fight, spit, use offensive language or place their feet on the seats.
- Throw any article inside, or out of, the train
- Alter, deface, misuse or fraudulently obtain a rail pass.
- Occupy seats while adults are required to stand.
- Give, lend or transfer their rail pass to another pass.
- Take short cuts across the train lines to reach another platform.
- Hold train doors open when they are closing.

In the event of a breach of any of the above conditions, State Rail Authority may confiscate a pass and may take legal action against the person to whom the pass is issued or refuse to grant any further travel concessions (**or**, all of the above).
